Motorcycle Trail



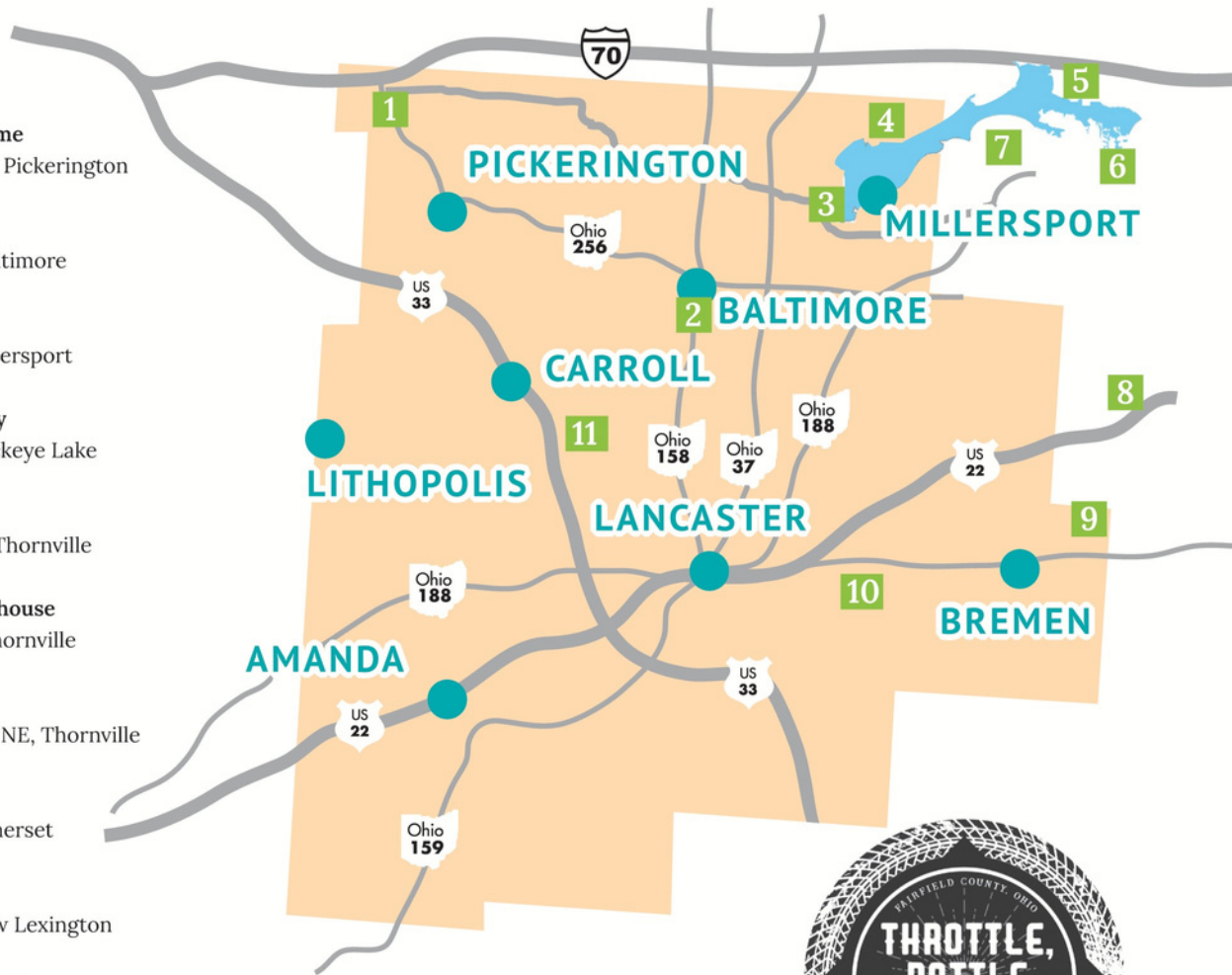
Start your adventure... at the **Motorcycle Hall of Fame Museum** in Pickerington and celebrate the heroes of the track, road, trails, and halls of government who have elevated the sport to new heights. Each of the incredible 100+ machines on display tells a unique story! Then, admire the beauty of Fairfield County's fair fields and pull up to the **Baltimore Pint House** for something tasty in what was once a historic bank, and head to local favorite **Weldon's Ice Cream** for a homemade, hand-dipped cone. Further down the road, you'll find the **Buckeye Lake Brewery**. Take in some of the area's best live music at **Papa Boo's**, and grab some BBQ and enjoy the cool outdoor space at **Port Lounge & Smokehouse**. Savor the view at **Buckeye Lake Winery** (be careful - gravel driveway). Enjoy the rural landscape as you cruise to Somerset and dive into the **Hole in the Wall!** Afterward, take in the scenery of the rolling hills to New Lexington's **Trotter's Pub & Grub** and enjoy the outdoor patio and a classic American menu. Hit the road and make a stop at **Rushcreek Pub and Grub** in downtown Bremen, with a final stop at the **Fillin' Station** in Carroll.
