

# Quick Facts About The Advent Window Walk



The Advent Window Walk is a living advent calendar in residential Downtown Lancaster.



Inspired by a popular Germanic Christmas tradition, the Advent Window Walk in Lancaster, Ohio is the only event of its kind in the nation (USA).



There will be a total of 27 window displays by December 26, this includes 24 residents of Historic Downtown Lancaster & 3 local non-profit organizations.



All 27 window displays are in the Historic district of Downtown Lancaster and can be viewed on foot in under 30 minutes!



The three local nonprofit organizations will create window artwork that celebrates Christmas Day, Kwanzaa & Hanukkah.



Windows can be viewed from a car for those who don't like being out in the cold! (Be mindful of traffic)



This year (2025) will mark the fourth annual Advent Window Walk in Downtown Lancaster!



Some participants will hold celebratory open houses on their special night!



The Advent Window Walk will run nightly from December 1st through December 31st, 6 - 10 p.m.



This event is a perfect opportunity for families and individuals to get out of the house, meet new community members, and explore downtown.
